



## AVA Community Agency Internship Program Project Ideas

Below is a list of potential project ideas that an intern may be able to work on during the Community Agency Internship program. Interns may also use their internship hours to support “business as usual” tasks for the agency; however, all work the intern engages in must not only meet the agency’s program needs, but also align with AVA’s objectives and the intern’s career and learning goals.

### Project ideas:

1. Projects related to supporting service delivery (e.g. creating presentation materials; facilitating presentations to service users)
2. Engaging in service user needs assessments and program innovation (i.e. program development)
3. Conducting evaluations (Program evaluations, intervention evaluations)
4. Projects related to agency data management
5. Projects related to Scholar’s IDP and research/education goals, as well as agency defined priorities
6. Grant writing, funding proposal applications
7. Diversifying agency programs and services
8. Designing strategy plans to co-create culturally safe workplaces and client- centered, culturally safe programs
9. Preparing and facilitating workplace training on integrated knowledge translation
10. Co-creating and co-delivering workplace training with a person with lived experience to agency staff
11. Generating knowledge on the process of creating culturally relevant, community- based supports for services users and agency staff
12. Designing an accessible foundation framework and data to support an agency’s project or programs’ aims
13. Co-developing a practice model for the agency to engage in innovative, community-based research with academic partners
