SSVE is a three-phase project aimed at developing an evidence-based and trauma-informed sexual violence educational program that highlights the complex historical and social dynamics that contribute to the continued victimization of women, girls, 2SLGBTQIA+, Indigenous peoples, newcomers, seniors, and individuals living with disabilities.
